

INSTRUCTIONS AND COMMUNITY USER GUIDES

- Anyone may post on the repositories by emailing their post to any of the email posting addresses.
- All materials posted are freely visible to the public globally.
- You may repost previously published works, your own thoughts, combinations of text or images and any common formats.
- For privacy security, scrub your metatags or put disinformation in any metatags or hidden data in your files.
- If you are working on collaborative documents or media works, with other users, be sure to put revision numbers on each draft.
- All postings must be compliant with, and assumed to be protected by: EU Privacy Rules, SLAPP/ANTI-SLAPP, Creative Commons, Fair Use Doctrine, U.N. Press Freedom Statutes, U.S. First Amendment, Freedom-of-the-Press, DMCA, International Free Speech Standards, ACLU precedents, EFF precedents, Privacy Rights Rules of Spain, National Journalism Standards and Related Standards.
- These policies are free-to-use for any public citizen journalism, news aggregation, WIKI, collaborative information space or social network site. No WIKI or document repository is responsible for reader comments, opinions, edits, or news feed content. Each blogger, author or WIKI entity is responsible for their own content or editing of content.
- If your posting involves revelation of a crime by public officials or large corporate entities, please assume that those parties will engage in cover-ups. Thus you should copy your posting to every relevant law enforcement agency and public media outlet.
- By posting in a repository you confirm that all media should be copied and redistributed by the public in order to support non-propaganda news and information distribution. Please copy this entire repository and host all, or part of it, on any extra space you have on your servers.
- Please Torrent, Bitchute, Gnutella and otherwise distribute this data via particulate crowd-distributed data flood systems in order to increase the distribution.
